**May 18, 2021** we begin our final iReady Diagnostics, IN SCHOOL, for virtual students. The Diagnostic offers a complete picture of student performance and growth, and an approximate end-of-year grade level for content that has been taught. Additionally, students tend to score better on assessments in the school building under a proctored environment. It is very important that students participate in all testing.

The Diagnostic takes **about 45-60 minutes** per subject (Math and Reading) The test is untimed, and students can take as much time as needed. Parents will be called upon completion.

Please bring your virtual student(s) to school for testing on the scheduled day, according to last name.

**STUDENTS: BE SURE TO BRING YOUR DEVICE (and charger)!**

**Students will need it to test and to return for the closing of the school year.**

Testing will take place on Tuesday-Friday, from **9:00am-1:00pm**. Lunch will be served. We will call parents for pick up as soon as their child has completed the test. (Students may finish early and parents will be called at that time.)

Once students have returned their device, they will receive asynchronous work for the remainder of the year. This means that they will receive a packet of grade level content that must be returned completed by Thursday, May 26, 2021 to be counted for attendance during this time. Work not returned will translate to absences.

K-2 students will receive a **STEAM Academy T-shirt** for participating. 3-8 students will receive a fun **STEAM Swag Bag**.

There are some things that would be helpful for the day of the test:

- Be sure student gets a good night's sleep.
- Be sure student eats a good breakfast.
- Be sure to show love and encouragement the morning of testing.
